Lesson Timetable

Teaching days are Monday to Friday. Your normal timetable will be from 9.30 to 13.00 for Academic Year and 9.00 - 15.30 for Academic Year Plus. However, in busy times, we may operate a 'zigzag' system. This means that your lessons may be timetabled any time between 9.30 and 17.30, and your schedule may vary from week to week.

Email our Questionnaire

Before you arrive, we will email you a questionnaire asking about your level, reasons for studying English and aims. Using this information, we will create a suggested course plan.



Level Test on First Day

On your first day, we will give you a spoken and written placement test to find your level of English. During the course, your teachers will monitor your progress. We can change your level on the General English course any week, when you and your teachers agree you are ready.



Meet Tutor & Discuss Course Plan

In your first week, you will meet your course tutor, who will discuss your course plan with you. This can be changed at any time. The course plan will take into consideration your level and our course dates.
