Course Overview

Our General English course is designed to give you a solid foundation in English and develop your ability to communicate. It is suitable for students of all levels from Elementary (A1) to Advanced (C1), but please note it is not suitable for complete beginners.

What will I study?

Our syllabus is specially designed so you can start any week. Lessons cover speaking, listening, reading and writing skills, plus grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation and study skills, with topics changing weekly. We do not follow a coursebook but instead use a wide range of teaching resources, and we provide you with all lesson materials. You can view the syllabus in full on our website.

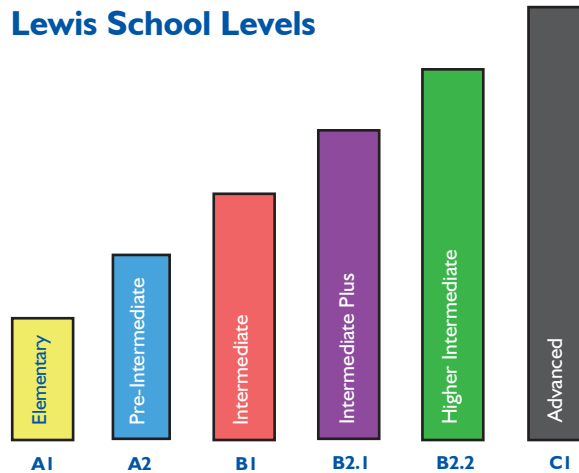
Your First Day

We give you a grammar test and short speaking test to find out your level, and place you in a suitable class. We also take you on a tour of the city centre. You will receive a folder and a Welcome Pack containing useful information about the school, the city and life in the UK.
