***Homestay deposit.** A non-refundable deposit of **10% of the total invoice value** is payable at the time of booking. Our recommended minimum age for homestay students in Southampton is 13. Junior homestay students share a room. This can be with students of the same or different nationality. In Southampton, bus passes are included for those on the homestay programme and our staff take students to the bus stop at the end of the school day.

****Residential deposit.** A non-refundable deposit of **GBP 45 per student per night** is payable at the time of booking.
