It is located on the edge of Ringwood, a historic market town in the New Forest National Park. You can follow our English Language Camp, which offers an exciting mix of English lessons and activities, or you can take part in our Theatre Camp or Art Camp, where you will have the chance to meet UK students.

*The age range is 12-17. However, we may accept a younger or older student from the same school year as someone else in the group.

Daytime & Evening Activities

- 5 afternoon and 2 evening activities per week (see timetable).
- Afternoon activities may include half-day trips, team games, arts and crafts (eg woodcraft, clay modelling, painting, felting, stop motion animation & baking), beach trips and visits to Ringwood
- Evening activities may include: bonfire, storytelling & barbecue, ceilidh (Irish/Scottish folk dancing), fish and chips on the beach, boat party and talent show.
