During our workshops you will practise the three main disciplines of the performing arts: singing, dancing and acting. You will learn the importance of effective warm-ups for voice and body and exercises to improve pronunciation and diction. You will acquire new skills and techniques to improve as a singer, dancer and actor, and most importantly you will enjoy learning how to take a piece of text and bring it to life. Each week we will work on an adaptation of a well-known West End musical: *Matilda*, *The Lion King*, *Wicked* and *School of Rock*. The themes within these stories will also be explored within your academic programme. Our students invariably find the performing arts are not only great fun, but also highly beneficial for their English. We can't wait to give you an unforgettable theatrical experience!

## Academic Programme

Lessons at the Lewis School are fast-paced and fun, and are based on our own syllabus, designed especially for young learners. All students complete a placement test on arrival, and each week there is the opportunity for promotion to a higher level.

- 15 hours of lessons per week
- Average 12-15 students per class (maximum 18)
- Levels are from Elementary (A1) to Advanced (C1)
- All learning materials provided
- Report and certificate at the end of the course
