

## Academic Programme

Lessons at the Lewis School are fast-paced and fun, and are based on our own syllabus, designed especially for young learners. All students complete a placement test on arrival, and each week there is the opportunity for promotion to a higher level.

- 15 hours of lessons per week
- Average 12-15 students per class (maximum 18)
- Levels are from Elementary (A1) to Advanced (C1)
- All learning materials provided. Report and certificate at the end of the course

## Residential Accommodation

- Full board accommodation in modern university residence, arranged by Lewis School
- Single study bedrooms with en-suite toilet, washbasin and shower facilities
- Bed linen and towels provided (laundry of bed linen and towels included)
- For washing of clothes, there is a coin- or card-operated laundry. Students required to pay for use
- Wi-Fi access in all bedrooms
